### **Search Team Announces Pastor Candidate!**

We have good news! The Pastor Search Team is now, hopefully, in the final stages of finding our new Pastor! Of the seven candidates we had to consider, **Jacques Van Rensburg** has won our team's unanimous vote of confidence. Tim Cole and our team



have carried out a thorough vetting process, and we feel Jacques is the best man for the job. He fully meets the qualifications of our job description and has demonstrated strong leadership skills in his current pastorate over the past 14 years, as well as in his previous ministries. Jacques is an evangelist at heart, a deeply-committed pastor, and a great husband and father. He genuinely desires to serve Christ and his church through the guidance of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God.

Jacques and his wife, **Lizelle**, first learned about the pastor search at New Hope through their friendship with Steve and Christina Morales. The Van Rensburg's are from South Africa and are doing a great job for the Lord there, but for some time now they have felt the Lord calling them to come to the United States to either start a church or to help an existing church reach more people for Jesus. Our search team has been asking God to make it absolutely clear who should be our next Pastor here at New Hope, and we believe God is doing just that. After fervent prayer, the search team is confident that **Jacques and Lizelle** are the people God wants to serve here.

This is a big decision for us all, so we are flying the Van Rensburg's to the U.S. to be with us from May 28<sup>th</sup> to June 14<sup>th</sup>. They will worship with us on June 2<sup>nd</sup> and then Jacques will preach for us on June 9<sup>th</sup>, the day of our church picnic so we can all get to know them better. We will also have a couple of informal Q&A Sessions to give everyone the opportunity to feel as solid about Jacques and Lizelle as we do. The members of New Hope will vote on Jacque's candidacy on June 16<sup>th</sup>. Both the Van Rensburg's and us need to know that New Hope is the Church that God is calling them to serve with. We thank you for your prayers and ask you to keep seeking the Lord's will with us. Please pray for Jacques and Lizelle by name because this is a very big change for them and their family.

I fully support the Search Team's recommendation to bring Jacques and Lizelle here at the end of May to see if God wants to put New Hope and the Van Rensburg's together in ministry. I was impressed with Jacque's answers on the questionnaire we gave our candidates and also the theological interview Tim Cole had with him on video. Even though he is not from our same fellowship of churches, Jacques is a nondenominational pastor who is true to the Lord and bases everything he does and believes on the Word of God. I am satisfied that he is a good fit for us theologically, but I encourage everyone to ask whatever questions you want to of him when he and Lizelle come here. It's obvious they both want to see the church grow and reach as many people as we can for Jesus. Please take the time while they are here to get to know them and to sense the tremendous hearts they have for the Lord.

Things are continuing to shape up for our mission trip to Liberia on May 23rd. Michael Briggs, Andrew and Christina Keeney, and I will team up for two leadership seminars, preach in two different churches, lead a one-day marriage seminar, and conduct a mass wedding ceremony and huge reception for many couples at the same time. It should be an encouragement to Caleb and Monika Sannoh's ministry there, and we thank you for your support and prayers.
